**Moorditj Koort Kwinana School Health Program provides local Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students with access to:**

715 Child Health Checks, GP's, Specialist, Health Education and Links into Community Services.

Moorditj Koort Aboriginal Health Practitioner (AHP), supports and monitors the health of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students enrolled in chosen schools.

The School Program strives to prevent and reduce the number of chronic illnesses in the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander community.



## What We Do

**Provide 715 Child Health Checks to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Island students enrolled at Medina, Orelia, Leda Primary School and Gilmore College**

**Moorditj Koort Schools Aboriginal Health Practitioner and local GP attend on site at local schools to perform student health checks.**

- 715 Child Health Check, Identify student health needs
- Provide support, advocacy on behalf of students/parent/guardian at GP, Allied Health and specialist appointments if required
- Link students into specialist, hospital and community services such as: Audiologist, ENT, Speech, Dental, Counselling, Dietitian, Diabetes Ed, Podiatry, Asthma Ed, PCH, Rockingham General Hospital, Fiona Stanley Hospital
- Provide Outreach transport to medical appointments
- Arrange appointments if needed
- Educate students on health and wellbeing topics
- Ensuring confidentiality at all times
